Nexus supports over 80 people providing both traditional and innovative services, including:

- Case management and coordination of supports.
- Supported accommodation - Nexus is a major provider of shared and individual supported housing.
- Capacity Building for major life transitions such as moving into independent accommodation.
- Flexible and in-home residential support.
- Community access and life skills development.

Nexus is focused on supporting people to live their lives as independently as possible.

Nexus has a turnover approaching \$10m which is funded under a number of State programs and the National Disability Insurance Scheme. Over 180 staff work to provide 24/7 services across accommodation and community locations.

Nexus is overseen by a volunteer community based Board who meet 8 to 10 times a year. The Board is skills based and includes members with varied professional and personal back grounds including small business, policy, corporate governance, mental health supports, the media, legal, finance, commercial and the disability sector.



Strategically the Board is focused on building capacity and awareness, preparation of our business systems for transition to the NDIS, and supporting staff to provide extraordinary client outcomes either directly or through our partnerships with a range of organisations.
