WHAT IS PLANNED RESPITE?

Our respite options are home-away-from-home style accommodations that are tailored to each person.

Respite can include a range of activities designed to increase capacity and create a fun and comfortable environment.

WHO DOES NEXUS SUPPORT IN RESPITE?

Nexus mainly supports Children and Youth at our planned respite location. Clients are usually aged 7-15 years old.

WHERE DOES NEXUS PROVIDE RESPITE?

We are pleased to support people in our new, purpose-built respite property 15 minutes drive North of the city.

DOES NEXUS PROVIDE EMERGENCY RESPITE

Our Respite team works mostly with planned respite. If you require emergency respite, please speak with our friendly team about your support needs.

HOW LONG CAN I STAY IN RESPITE WITH NEXUS

We tailor planned Respite to the needs of clients and their families. This might be for one or two nights, or a few weeks.

You can stay with us over weekends, week-days, or holidays. We have access to a Nexus vehicle to transport you to and from school or activities.

WHAT FUNDING DO I NEED?

Planned Respite is funded through the Short Term Accommodation/STA or Respite part of your NDIS plan.



HOW MANY PEOPLE WILL I SHARE WITH?

This is dependent on both funding level and personal choice, so our Respite team will work with you to find an option that you are most comfortable with.

WHAT DO NEXUS RESPITE HOUSES HAVE?

In our purpose-built Respite property we have three 2-bedroom units.

Each unit has:

- A bathroom for each bedroom
- Wi-Fi
- Shared living and dining areas
- Fully equipped kitchen
- Vehicle access

And access to a shared:

- Communal area
- Fenced garden
- Sensory area
